

## Removal procedures for specific stains

for textile contract floor coverings made of synthetic fibres by

#### Stain remover for carpets made from synthetic fibres

1 Fleck&Weg (with active oxygen)

2 Fleckenspray R

#### The four basic rules for stain removal:

1. Treat the stains immediately. The sooner you treat the stain, the easier and more successful its elimination.
2. Treat stains from the edge towards the centre to avoid spreading and smearing.
3. Never rub hard. Rubbing can lead to the fibres becoming tangled. Take your time and don't rush. Rushing can make the stained area worse or even damage the material.
4. Use the correct stain remover. Home remedies such as lubricants or neutral soap, detergent, window cleaner, ammonia or turpentine can cause damage to the fibres or lead to the treated areas becoming even more stained.

#### Instructions and additional information on the appropriate stain removal:

1. Soak up liquids with an absorbent cloth, vacuum loose dirt.
2. Identify stains by means of the stain table and select the recommended stain remover.

3. Before applying always check the material to be cleaned for colour and material resistance by using the stain remover on an inconspicuous area.
4. Spray stain remover on a clean, absorbent, lint-free cloth and remove the stain by dabbing from the edge towards the centre. For this purpose, special knitted microfibre cloths have proven efficient. Never rub hard.
5. Dab the dissolved stain substances using a clean, dry section of the cloth or a separate absorbent towel.
6. In case of stubborn stains repeat the procedure if necessary.
7. To conclude the treatment use clear water and pat dry. If necessary, use a dry cloth to absorb the residual liquid and weight down.
